INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

1 Kng 19:9a, 11-13a *Elijah recognized God in the tiny whispering sound.*

Psalms 85 "Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation."

Rom 9:1-5 *Paul speaks the truth in Christ.*

Matt 14:22-33 *Jesus walks on the sea.*

"Lord, if it is you," cries Peter when he sees Jesus walking on the water. No wonder he sank! No wonder Jesus scolds him, "O you of little faith!" Our readings today challenge us to have enough faith to find God in the most unexpected places: in a tiny whispering sound, or in the middle of the sea in a raging storm. As we listen to God's holy word today, let us recall the unlikely places where we have found God and give thanks.

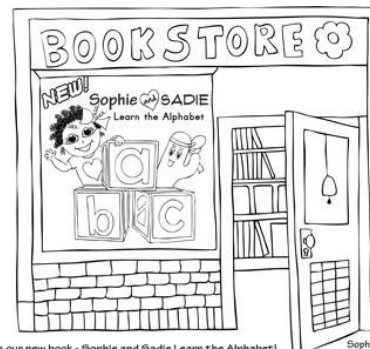
