

INTRODUCTION TO LITURGY OF THE DAY

On the last two Sundays we heard Jesus calling his first disciples. Over the next three Sundays, we will hear stories of Jesus healing the sick and afflicted. He is just beginning his public ministry but as he drives out demons and heals lepers, his renown and his popularity increase quickly. In today's Gospel, Jesus drives out an unclean spirit. The people are astonished, not just at his actions, but also how he taught with such authority.

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

Deuteronomy 18:15-20 I will raise up a prophet and I will put my words into his mouth.

Psalms 95 "If today you hear his voice, Harden not your hearts."

1 Corinthians 7:32-35 A virgin is anxious about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy.

Mark 1:21-28 He taught them as one having authority.

In the first reading we hear God promise Moses that God will raise up a prophet like him "and will put my words into his mouth." Mark then presents Jesus as being a prophet. He astonishes the people of Capernaum by teaching at the synagogue with authority, then encountering a man with unclean spirit and immediately driving the unclean spirit out by his command.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What kind of unclean spirits" afflicting some people do I encounter? Do I risk becoming unclean myself when encountering those who are afflicted? Can I overcome that risk?
